Please ensure you read our Booking Kit in its entirety and sign the Booking Form before returning by scanning and email to your Customer Service Representatives email address.

Final Student Numbers & Payment Terms

The cost of Vacation Care excursions as at 3/3/2011 is \$25.00 per child. Please contact the Event Co-ordinator on 0422 728 083 to finalise numbers no later than two weeks prior to the event date. Upon receipt of your booking kit, YGFA will send you an invoice for a 50% deposit to secure your booking to be paid within 7 days. The final payment invoice, reflecting the balance e will be due 2 weeks prior to the event. We do not accept payment on the day under any circumstances as stock is needed to be ordered for your event prior to. As there are 60 booking spaces per vacation care event, once your final numbers are given they cannot change. There are to be under no circumstances any extra children on the day of the event.

Wet Weather Postponement

Postponement of an excursion due to inclement weather must occur by 12pm on the day prior to the excursion date. A new date will be allocated that suits the client subject to availability. Young Guns Fishing Adventures reserves the right to Postpone an event at their discretion if the weather conditions pose risk to YGFA s staff or students.

Excursion Cancellation

The cancellation of a booking (unrelated to inclement weather) must be confirmed no later than two weeks prior to the excursions booked date or will incur a cancellation fee of 50% of the total fee.

Minimum Numbers and Group Size

Minimum numbers for a single vacation care Group is 20. There are no refunds for any booking that falls under 20 children on the day under any circumstances. Group size for Vacation events cannot exceed 60 children in accordance with YGFA risk management policies.

Excursion Start and Finish Times

Standard start and finish times for Vacation care events are between 10am and 2pm. We are able to change to meet the needs of your Vacation Care group.

What to Wear?

All guests are advised to wear flat, covered footwear (not gumboots) a broad-brimmed hat, appropriate and comfortable clothing and rain gear if necessary. Sunscreen and insect repellent is provided.

First Aid
